

## New Website Goes Live May 14<sup>th</sup>!

For the past several months, we have been working to develop a new website using a platform called Club Express. Due to the herculean efforts of Doug Sacarto and Janene Centurione, the new site is ready to launch! Unlike our old website, which was entirely open to the public and rather static, this new website will be much more colorful, interactive, and, most importantly, will combine our old manual method of maintaining our membership roles, sharing of documents, and sharing information about League with our members and the public. **This new website will launch on Thursday, May 14<sup>th</sup>!** Our web address will remain the same.

What does this mean for you? Because this new website will allow for members-only content, and for you to maintain your membership information yourself, the site allows each member to have his or her own log-in. When the site goes live, you will be receiving an automatically-generated e-mail with a temporary password, inviting you to log-in and create your own password. We encourage all of our members to join the Club!

Below is an excerpt of the e-mail that will be sent to you this week. Please do not think this e-mail is spam or junk mail! If you don't receive the e-mail, you might check your Spam mail folder to see if it went there.

If you have any trouble logging in to the new site, help is available. The automatic e-mail tells you how to reach out.

To access your account, go to the website at <<link will be in e-mail>>, then click the "Member Login" option at the top of the page to log in. Here is your account login info:

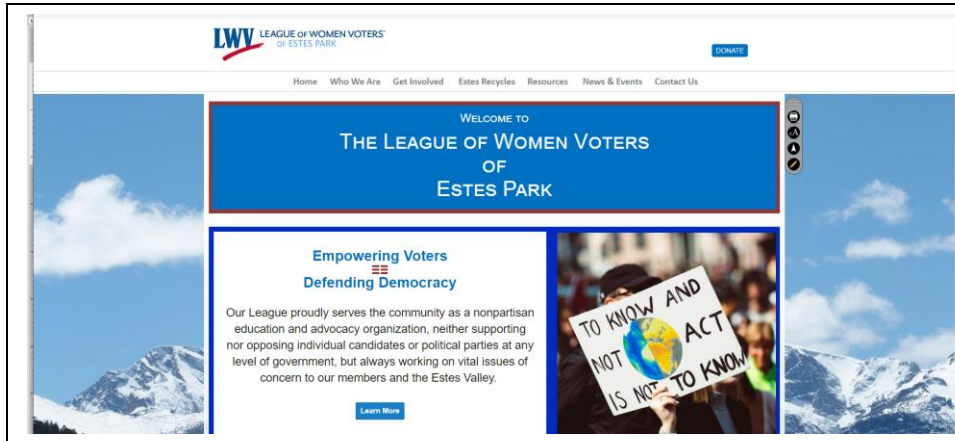
